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EMPLOYER OBLIGATIONS IN THE CONTRACT CLEANING INDUSTRY

If you engage one (1) or more workers to perform cleaning in the contract cleaning industry in Queensland, you must register with the Contract Cleaning Industry (Portable Long Service Leave) Authority. Registration must be done within seven (7) days of engaging an eligible worker. Eligible workers include employees who are casual, part-time, full time or contractors (ABN Sole Trader).

Please note: Registration is not optional. Registration is a legal requirement. Penalties apply for failing to register.

Employers must also do the following:

- Submit an employer return and levy payment within 14 days of the end of each quarter.
- Keep the relevant books and records to support each worker's engagement
- Advise changes to the employer contact details provided within 14 days after the change.

LONG SERVICE LEAVE BENEFITS

When workers have 10 years of recorded service, the Scheme will make long service leave payments according to the *Contract Cleaning Industry (Portable Long Service Leave) Act 2005* [the 'Act'].

This can be done either by paying the worker directly, or by reimbursing the employer if they have paid the worker under the provisions of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999* (reimbursement should be claimed by the employer within three months of paying the worker).

DEFINITIONS

Contract cleaning industry:

The industry in which individuals are engaged to perform cleaning work for other people.

Cleaning work:

Work that has, as its main or only function, the bringing of premises into, or keeping of premises or public open spaces in a clean condition.

Premises:

- INCLUDES houses, buildings and public open spaces (for example Southbank Parklands).
- EXCLUDES planes, trains, boats, vehicles, swimming pools, and grounds surrounding a building, house or swimming pool.

A worker:

A worker is an individual who is engaged to perform cleaning work in the contract cleaning industry

ABN workers may be eligible workers if they meet the definitions above but would be excluded if they are deemed to be any of the trading entities listed below:

- 1. Sole traders who engage other workers to perform cleaning work
- 2. Trustee of a Trust
- 3. Proprietary Limited Company
- 4. Partner in a partnership

An employer:

An employer is a person who engages one or more individuals to perform cleaning work in the contract cleaning industry.



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
